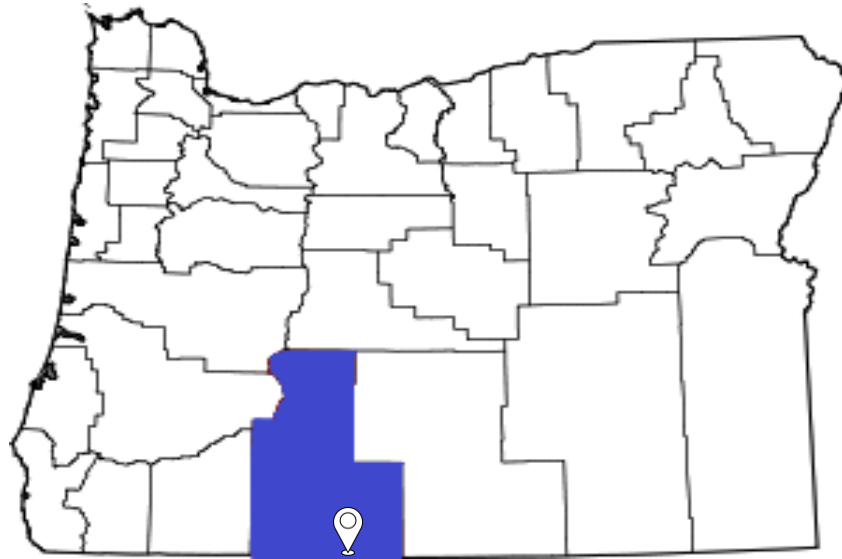


MALIN, OREGON

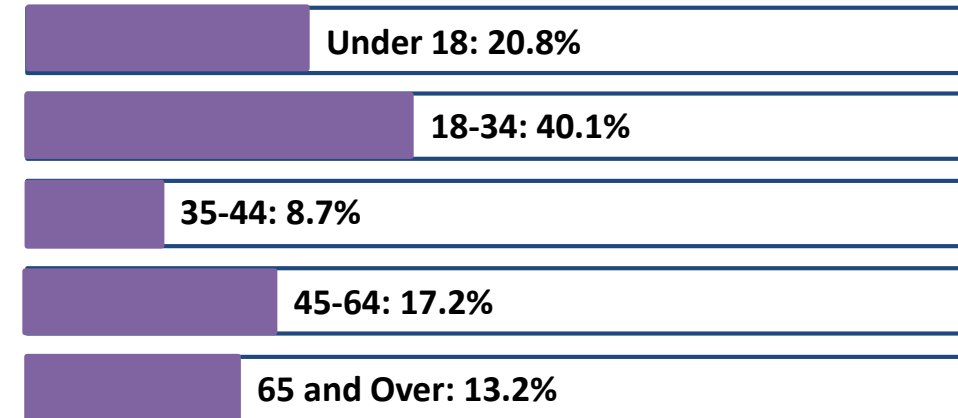

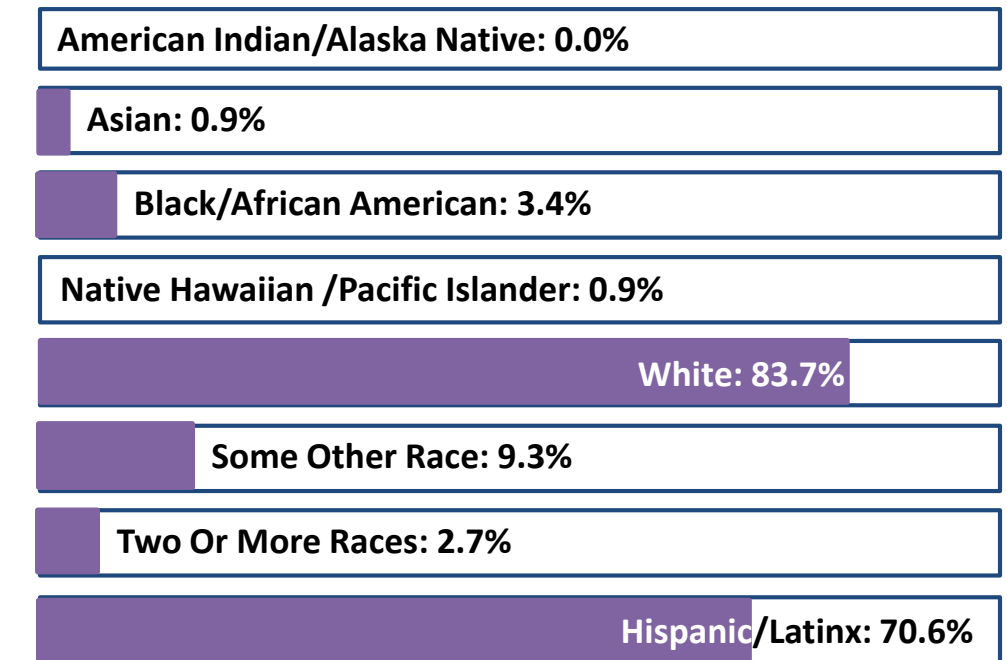
POPULATION CHANGE (from 2010 to 2018)

POPULATION BY AGE



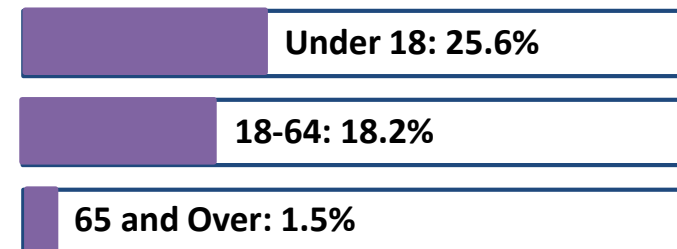

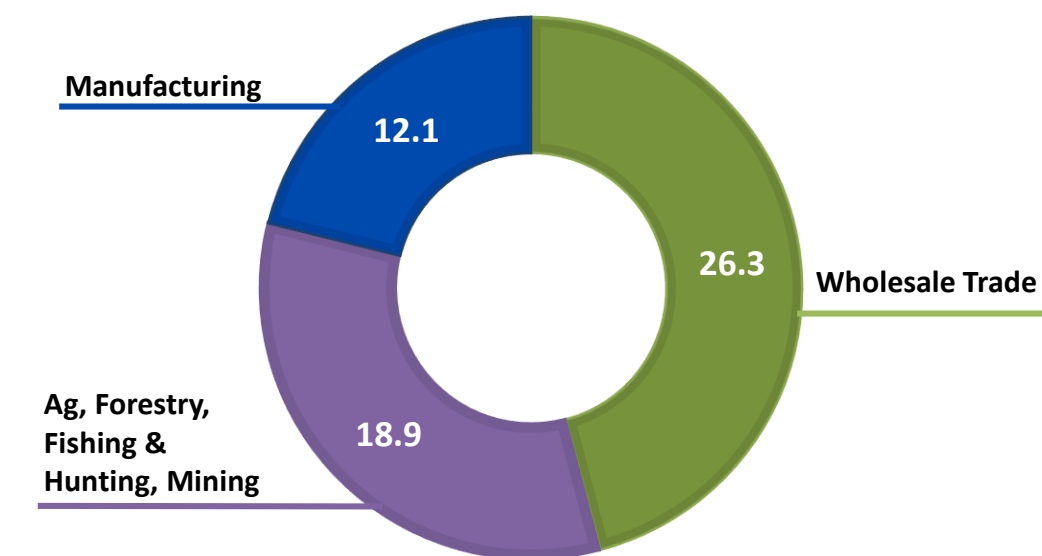
