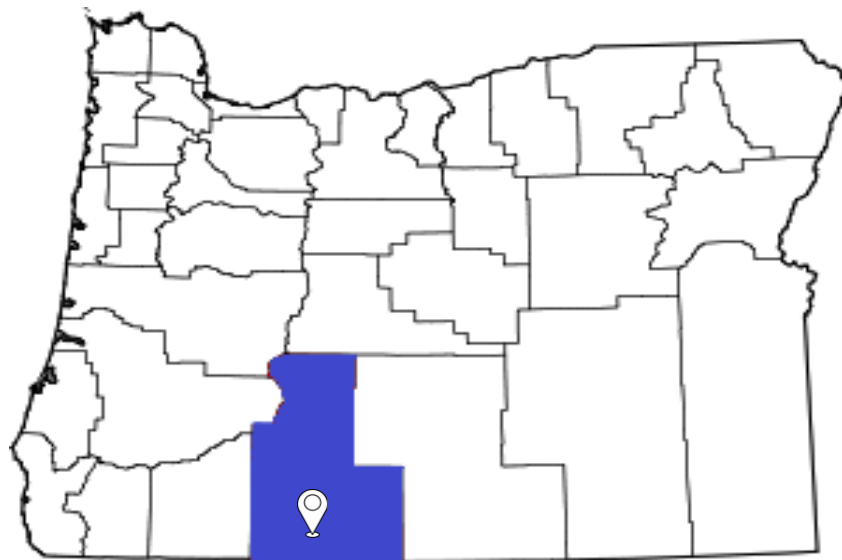


ALTAMONT, OREGON

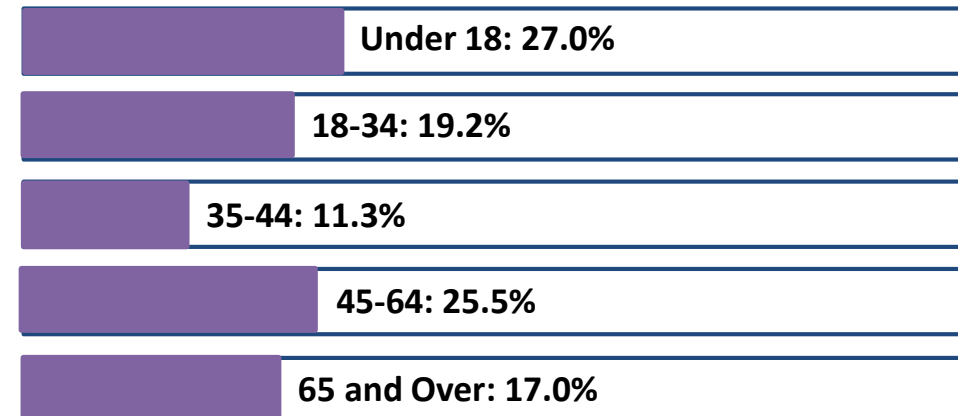

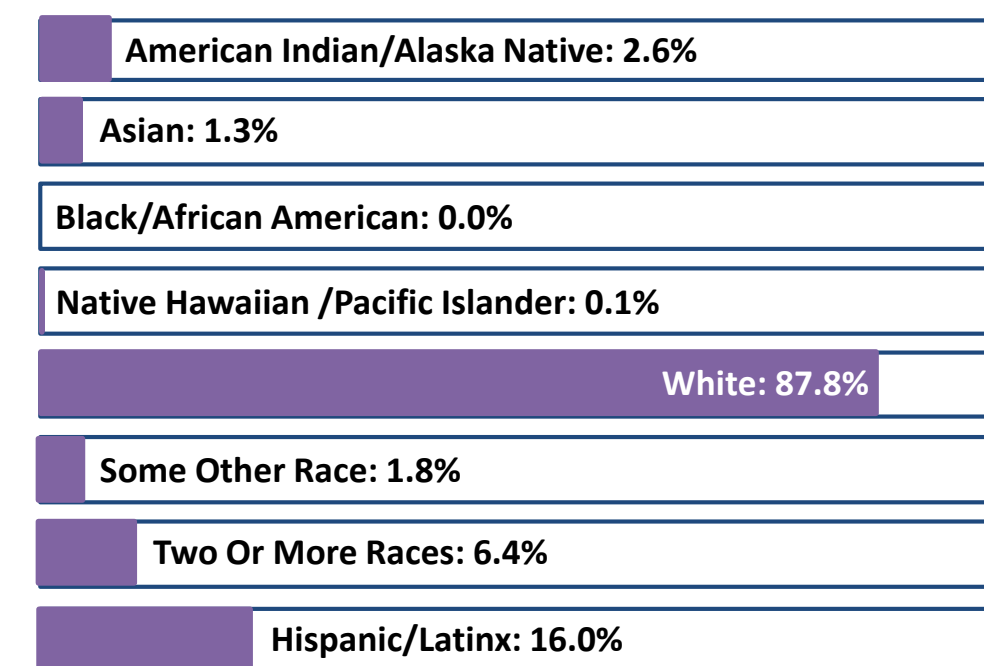

POPULATION BY AGE



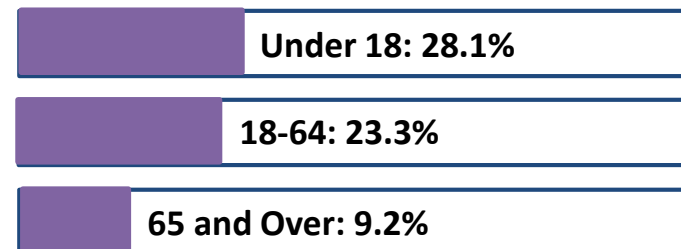

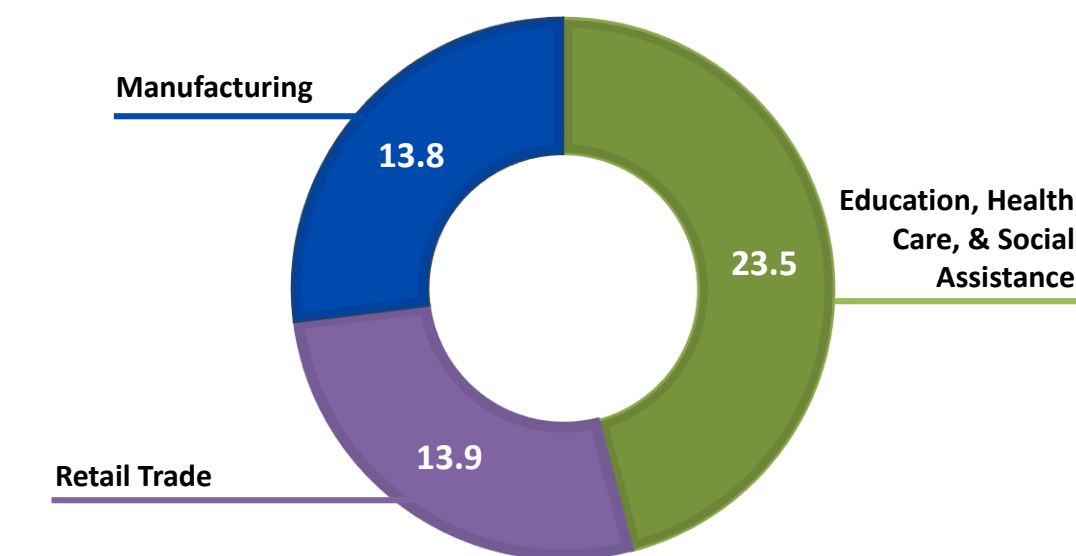
