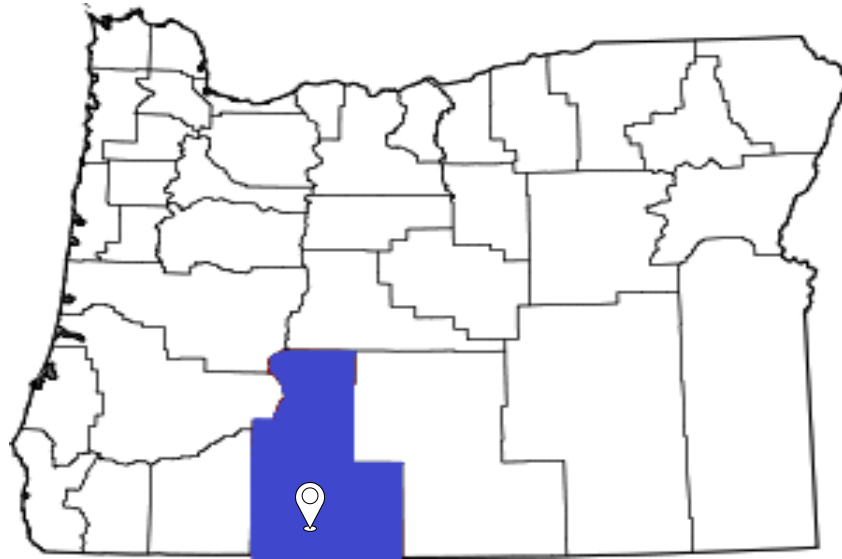


KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON

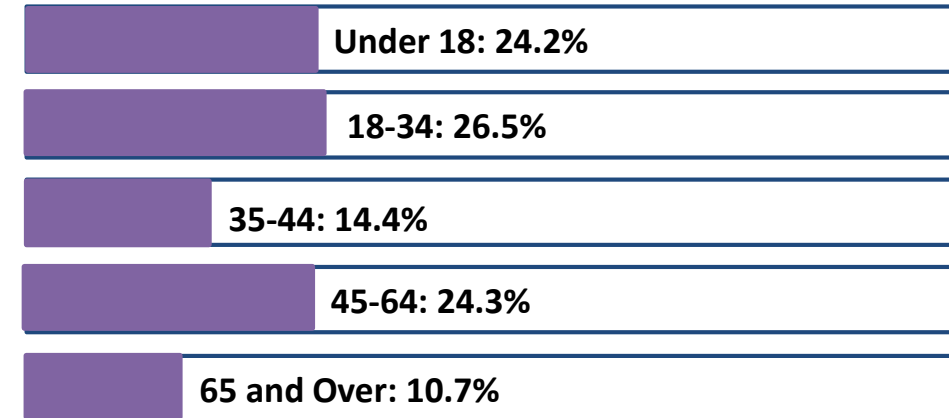

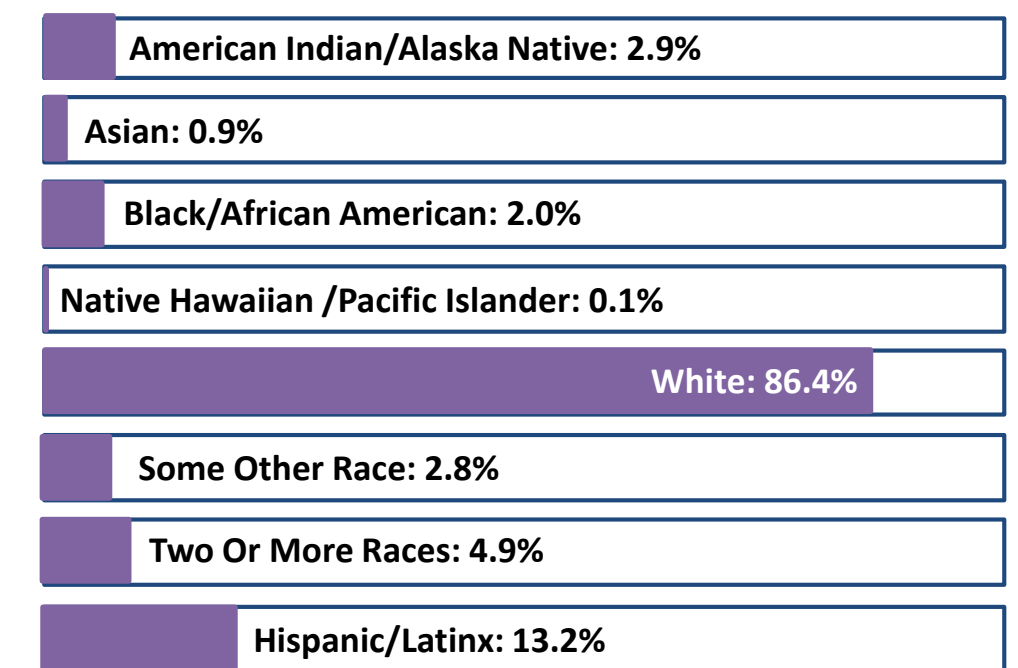

POPULATION BY AGE



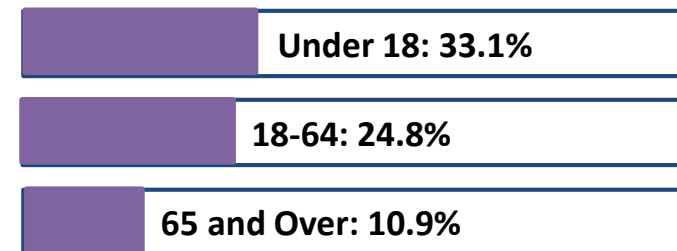

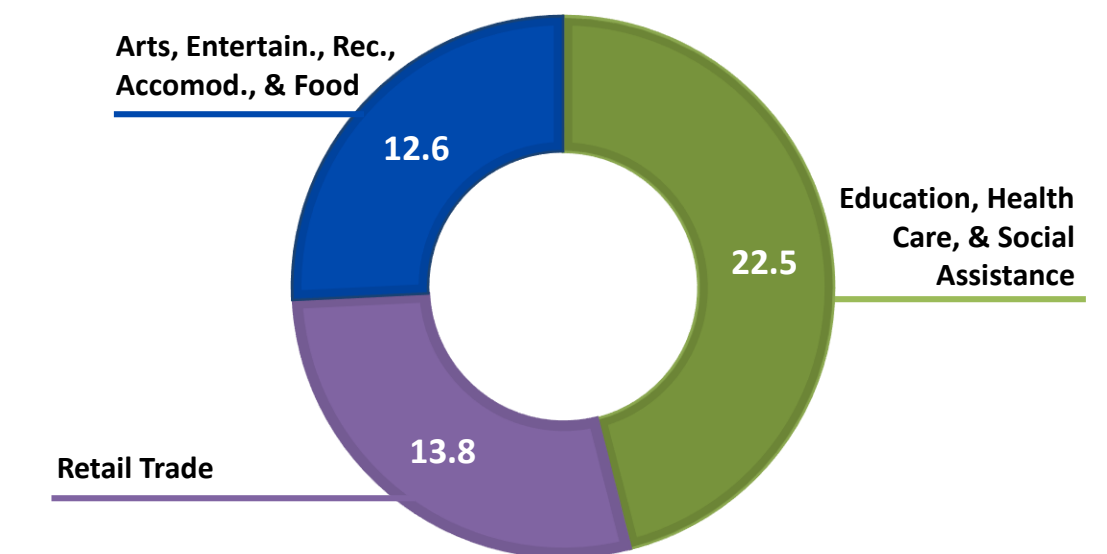
